



Onboarding Instructions

ReadCloud can be accessed from its native apps, a web browser, your LMS or OneNote.

This factsheet walks you through your first steps with ReadCloud - including our Single Sign-On feature and a first look at your Bookshelf.

1. Download ReadCloud

Choose the device you are using and follow the prompts to install the app on your device.

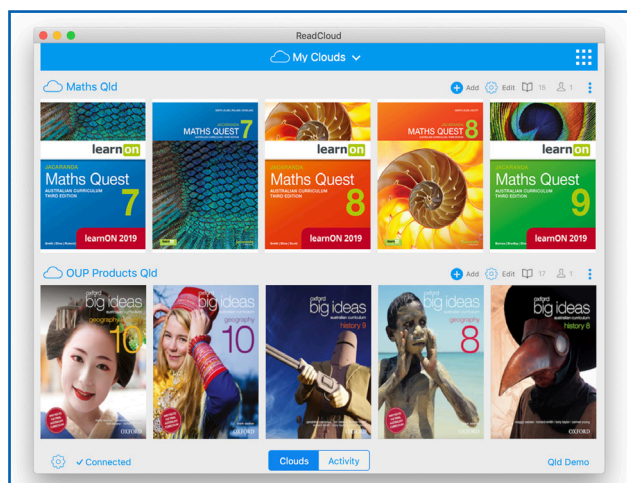

2. Login into ReadCloud

Enter your school email address and click **Next**. You can now enter your school's default password or login with Office 365 with your school network credentials.

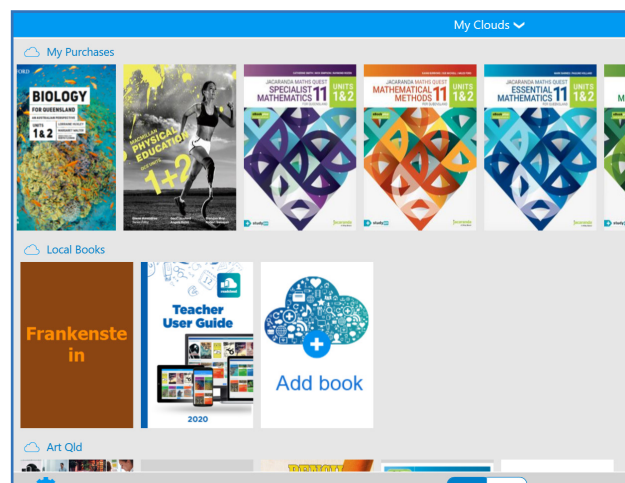
3. Your Bookshelf

ReadCloud's virtual Class Clouds mimic your physical classes. Your bookshelf is the first thing you will see after you log in.



4. Access your digital resources

Your bookshelf contains your digital resources for your current school year. There are three system clouds: My Purchases, My Interactive Logins and Local Books, together with your virtual school clouds.
