Our strategy will be to


• Review student performance data throughout the year.

This data will include:

- a) NAPLAN Data and targeted Literacy and Numeracy data,
- b) PAT Reading and PAT Mathematics data captured twice annually in Years 8 and 9,
- c) PROBE reading test, implemented throughout each year for targeted students,
- d) Level of Achievement in English, Mathematics and Science and continuous assessment data.
- Review annually our Literacy and Numeracy improvement strategies and adjust to meet the needs of particular year level group,
- Review twice yearly Student Individual Learning Plans (ILP) and Evidence Based Plans (EBP) to ensure they cater for individual student needs towards meeting NMS,
- Communicate with Parents/Guardians our strategy and their students' progress,
- Implement a Literacy and Numeracy program additional to timetabled curriculum time. This will be delivered at regularly junctures during Year 8 and 9 in 2014/5,
- Purchase take-home resources to support students working towards NMS in Literacy and/or Numeracy in 2014,
